

Results in from member survey on county tree mortality

The first survey of the year, developed by the Local Government Relations Committee, went out to members on 2/8 and 2/11. Forty-five members responded, which represented a 16% response rate. *Visit Survey Monkey Website link to review survey results – https://www.surveymonkey.com/results/SM-9VZRHDVW/*

In response to the first question – what % of transactions fall through because of county tree mortality issues – about 84% of respondents said almost none or only 5 – 10%. One member commented that this dominant response makes sense because tree mortality issues on a property cause a buyer to walk away before any real transaction has occurred. 11.36% of respondents stated 10 – 25% of transactions fall through because of tree mortality.

In response to question 2 – what is the % of clients having significant concern about tree mortality-34% of respondents judged that 5 – 20% of clients have significant concern; almost 16% of respondents judged that 20 – 40% of clients have significant concern about tree mortality.

Not surprisingly, almost 78% of respondents judged that the expense of removing dead trees was the tree mortality issue of greatest significance to clients.

Questions 4 and 5 asked whether or not clients and T.C.A.R. members have adequate information about tree mortality issues and possible remedies. Almost 38% of respondents described clients as not being well educated on tree mortality issues; 49% of respondents described clients as having only "some" information. Almost 67% of members who responded said they were "very interested" in becoming better informed about the pervasive tree mortality issue in the county.

The March 10 General Membership meeting will provide updates on other county resources. Tracie and Larry Beil, County GIS Coordinator, will discuss the status of the local state of emergency due to drought, and the effect on residential wells. Thomas Haglund, TUD General Manager, and Lisa Westbrook will talk about progress with the TUD Capital Improvement Plan.

Supervisors adopt an ordinance on 2/2 to address medical marijuana cultivation

With certain restrictions, a qualified patient or primary caregiver may cultivate up to 12 marijuana plants outdoors or 24 plants indoors. The Board also approved that enforcement for violations of the medical marijuana cultivation ordinance will fall under the Health and Safety Code. The marijuana cultivation ordinance was passed by a yes vote from 3 supervisors. Supervisors Hanvelt and Rodefer abstained, citing issues related to the current status of federal marijuana regulation.

From the MLS Director's Desk: Ofelia Ontiveros MLS Director

The TCAR MLS is "mandatory submission" per MLS Rules & Regulations: (Excerpt from TCAR MLS R&R)

CLICK HERE FOR COMPLETE TCAR MLS RULES & REGS PDF **7.5 Mandatory Submission.** Broker Participants shall input exclusive right to sell or exclusive agency listings on one to four unit residential property and vacant lots located within the service area of the MLS within 2 days after all necessary signatures of the seller(s) have been obtained on the listing or at the start date of the listing, whichever is later. Only those listings that are within the service area of the MLS must be input. Open listings or listings of property located outside the MLS's service area (see section 7.7) are not required by the service, but may be input at the Broker Participant's option.

7.6 Exempted Listings. If the seller refuses to permit the listing to be disseminated by the service, the listing broker shall submit to the service a certification signed by the seller that the seller does not authorize the listing to be disseminated by the service.





About the Training Requirement

REALTORS® are required to complete ethics training of not less than 2 hours, 30 minutes of instructional time within four-year cycles. The training must meet specific learning objectives and criteria established by the National Association of REALTORS®.

The current four-year cycle will end Dec. 31, 2016.

Training may be completed through local REALTOR® associations or through another method, such as home study, correspondence, classroom courses, or online courses.
