



What is Geothermal Energy?

- Geothermal is the heat from the Earth
- · It is a clean, renewable, limitless source of energy
- Energy extracted using geothermal heat pumps (GHPs) can provide heating, cooling, and hot water to homes and commercial buildings, while utilizing average ground temperatures between 40°and 70°F
- GHPs have heating efficiencies of 50 to 70% higher than other heating systems and cooling efficiencies of 20 to 40% higher than available air conditioners

How It Works

- GHP heating systems circulate water to pull heat from the Earth through pipes in a continuous loop
- During the winter, the circulated water collects heat from the earth and carries it through the system and into the building
- During the summer, the system reverses itself to cool the building by pulling heat from the building, carrying it through the system and placing it in the ground
- Residential systems that are equipped with de super heaters transfer excess heat from the geothermal heat pump's compressor to the house's hot water tank

Advantages

- Since Earth's interior produces a constant flow of power and energy, geothermal energy is available year-round
- The pipe used carries up to a 50-year warranty and is manufactured by Centennial Plastics
- No exposed equipment outdoors; children or pets cannot injure themselves or damage exterior units
- Geothermal heat pump projects may qualify for either the Federal Investment Tax Credit or the Production Tax
 Credit
- Climate Master geothermal systems save substantial costs in heating, cooling and hot water production compared to traditional HVAC systems
